

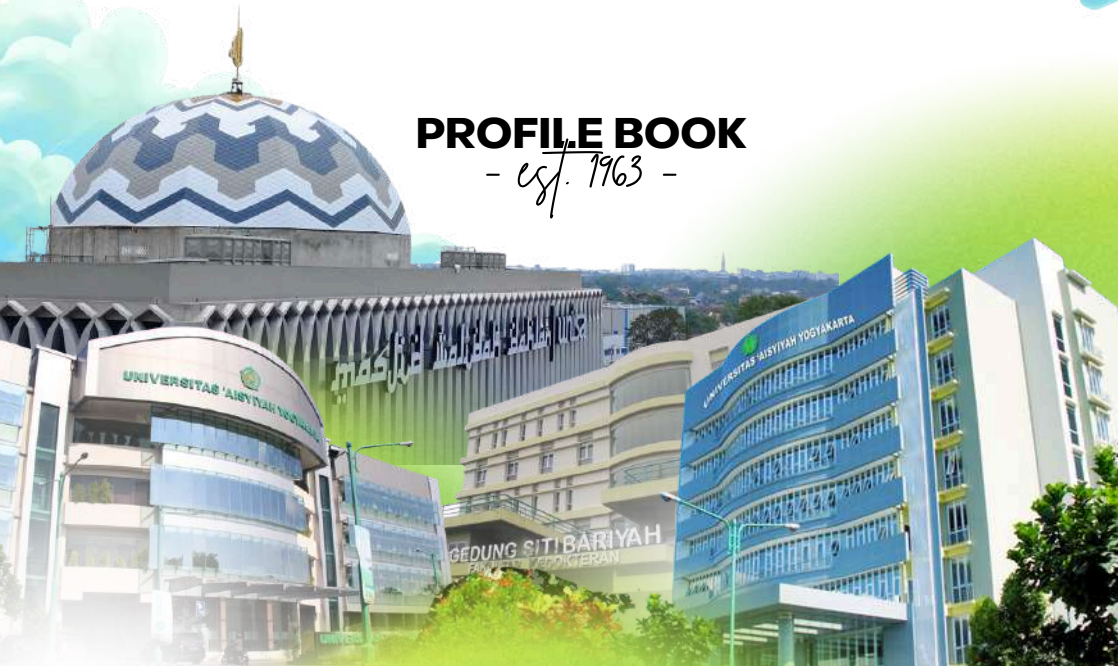

Subsequently, the **Sekolah Panjenang Tingkat C 'Aisyiyah** (Nursing school level C) was also opened at the PKU Muhammadiyah Hospital in Yogyakarta.
